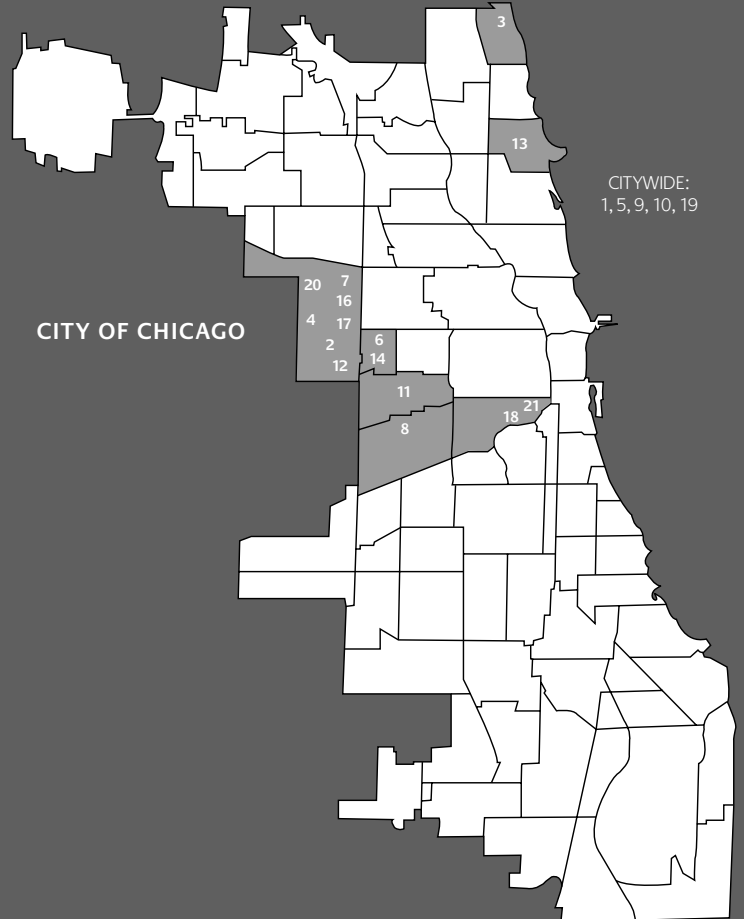

Community Economic Development **GOODCITY PARTNERS WITH CHICAGO'S EMPOWERMENT ZONE TO ADMINISTER \$1.5 MILLION IN GRANTS TO 57 SMALL BUSINESSES**

Wallace E. Goode, Executive Director of Chicago's Empowerment Zone (EZ), selected Goodcity to be program administrator for grants to 57 small businesses in the Zone. The grants were used to purchase equipment, expand inventory or upgrade facilities. The project introduced Goodcity to even more people working to meet community needs.

Pastor Curlie Anderson leads the New Way of Life Missionary Baptist Church at 5353 West North Avenue and with his wife, Pamela Anderson, operates Curlie's Bakery next door. The bakery employs seven and specializes in caramel cakes, butter cookies, and wedding cakes.

Pastor Anderson operates the bakery to provide jobs for those living in the church's homeless shelter for men recovering from drug and alcohol addiction. Pastor Anderson estimates that 30% of the shelter residents are ex-offenders who can't get jobs.

The bakery received a \$21,000 EZ grant to purchase a walk-in cooler, single rack oven, donut fryer, and icing machine. Curlie's operates a growing wholesale business -selling to 21 Walgreen stores, Chicago Public Schools, several White Hen Pantries, and local barbecue restaurants. Pastor Anderson says his goal is to expand to a larger facility and hire the shelter residents who can't get jobs. *"Our production is limited here. We are running this business to continue to help the people that need help."*

Tajuana Patterson, a former teacher and technology coordinator in Chicago Public Schools who founded Blim's Learning Center at 4638 W. Monroe 20

months ago, received a \$13,000 EZ grant to purchase bassinets, developmental toys, and computers so parents can observe their children at the child care center. *"My major goals are a larger space, to be able to provide transportation, and to computerize everything to cut down on the paperwork."* Her motivation to enter the low-paying child care business – *"wanting to do something so children aren't so far behind when they enter school. I've never been in it for the money. I don't believe you can put any price on a child's education."*

When asked about their experience dealing with Goodcity, all the business owners agreed that the process operated efficiently. Ms. Wright, owner of Wright Fit Uniforms, said, *"I have two Empowerment Zone grants and there is no comparison. Goodcity's process is simpler to deal with. You don't have to go through so many layers."* Wallace Goode put it simply, *"Goodcity helped us create an express lane for processing the paperwork."*

GOODCITY'S LATINO INITIATIVE REACHES OUT TO LATINO-LED ORGANIZATIONS IN CHICAGO

Since the inception of Goodcity's Latino Initiative in September, 2002, Jacob Perez, Goodcity's Latino Initiative Director, has met with more than 20 Latino-led organizations in Chicago. As a result of this outreach, Goodcity recently formalized a partnership with the Telpochcalli Community Education Project (TCEP), based at Telpochcalli Public School at 24th and California. Telpochcalli, meaning 'house of youth,' serves 300 children in grades K-8 in a former high school building shared with Saucedo Academy. Telpochcalli doesn't have its own gym so the students attend

only one gym class per week. The school also lacks an auditorium, a lunchroom, or any space to host large school events, concerts, or performances. In spite of these physical deficits, it is effectively integrating Mexican art and culture throughout its curriculum and graduating students that are truly bi-lingual and bi-cultural.

TCEP's mission is to increase the capacity and participation of Pilsen/Little Village residents in the formation of a more united, educated, safer, and socially prepared community, through a community cultural center directed by the residents themselves. There are few programs or facilities to address the educational or recreational needs of the people in this Pilsen/Little Village community where 36% of the over 29,000 residents are under 19. Although there is very little open space in the community, TCEP has its eye on a former R.O.T.C. building, lawn, and parking lot in front of the school. This space, owned by Chicago Public Schools,

is listed as waiting for an addition on the CPS Capital Improvement Plan for the years 2001-2004 but no funding is currently allocated to the project.

Goodcity is helping TCEP with strategic planning, partnership development, fiscal management, and access to resources that can help them make their vision of a locally directed Community Culture and Education Center a reality.

Goodcity provides fiscal management and capacity building through workshops and one-on-one support to twenty other faith- and community-based programs in Chicago. We help organizations and churches teach financial literacy classes to immigrants, refugees, and low-income working parents. 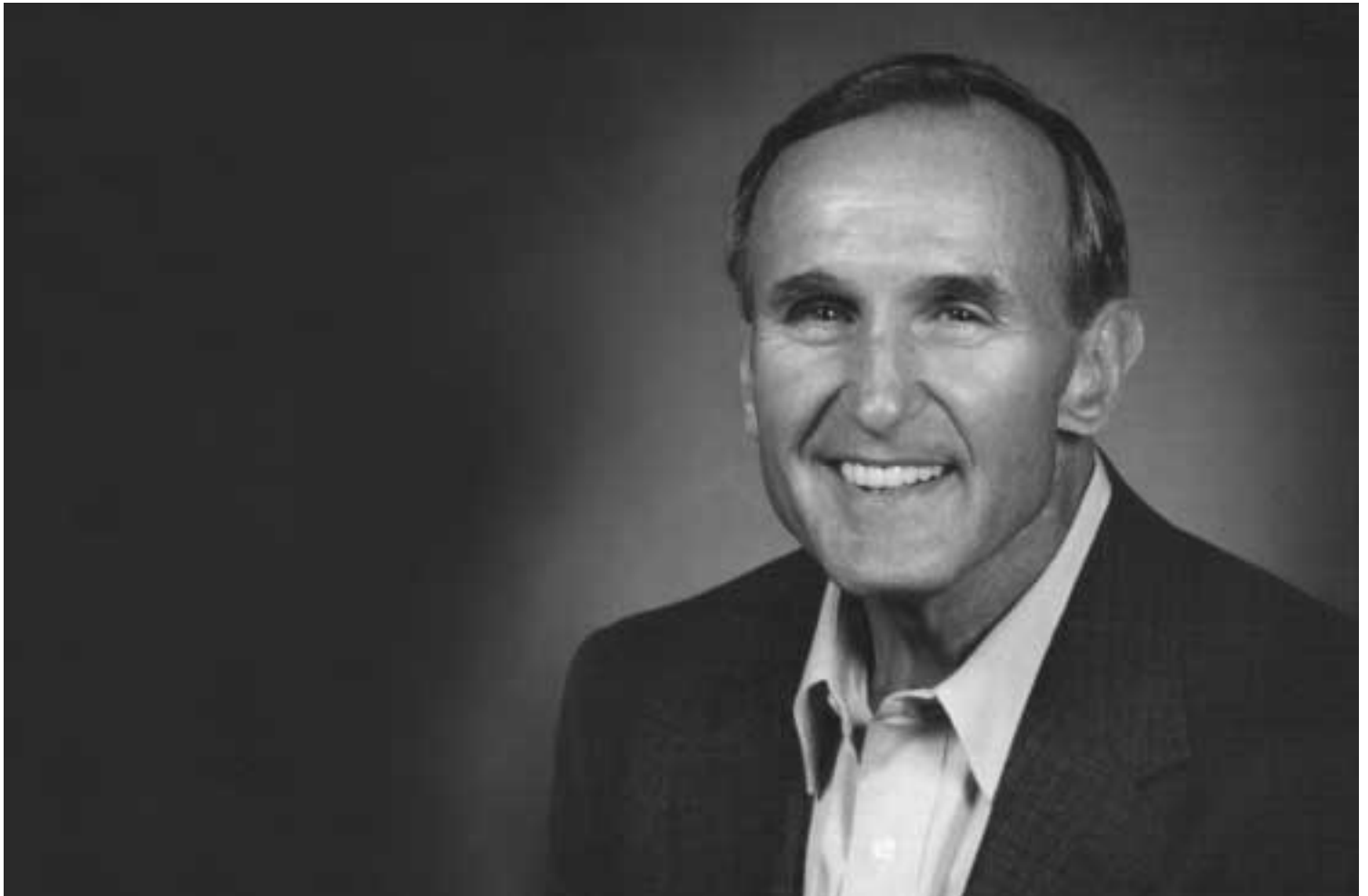

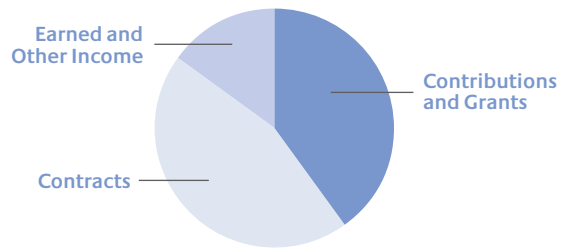

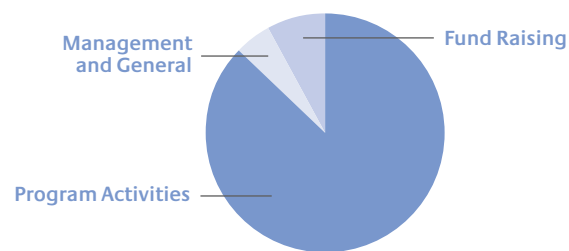
